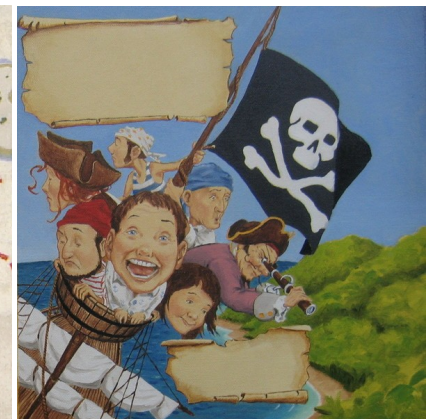




TREASURE HUNT around Novara

Stay with your team !!!**





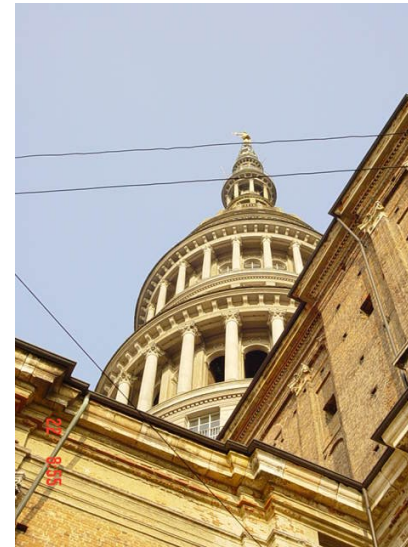
1a. This is Novara's "Castello sforzesco". What was the name of the family who owned the castle in the past?

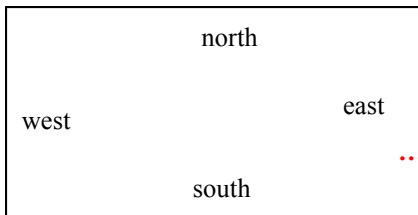


4. There is a Christmas exhibition in this Church every year. What does it usually display? (ask passers-by if you do not know)
